Work on the Town of Floyd Comprehensive Plan will begin in October. The Floyd Town Council and the Town of Floyd Planning Commission will work with the New River Valley Regional Commission to begin revising the Plan to identify community goals and aspirations in respects to community development. Be on the lookout for upcoming surveys and input sessions in the near future.

The Town's Heritage Trail sidewalk project along Oxford Street is steadily progressing. We anticipate a Spring 2018 construction start date.
