MINUTES

MEETING CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Griffin called the December 3, 2015 meeting of the Floyd Town Council to order.

ROLL CALL – Vice-Mayor Turner, Councilman LeMay, Mayor Griffin, Town Manager Cox, and Town Clerk Mandzak were present. Councilman Patton, Councilwoman Bingham, and Town Attorney Shortt were absent.

CITIZENS COMMENT PERIOD-

None

CONSENT CALENDAR-

- A. November 5th and November 19th minutes- Vice-Mayor Turner asks that the minutes be tabled until more members of the Council are present.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

- A. Harris Street Public Input-Town Manager Cox presents a letter and pictures submitted by Blair Clark from Clark Gas & Oil concerning Harris Street; Clark Gas & Oil requests that there be no parking on Harris Street during business hours (7:00am to 5:00pm) Monday through Friday, they also request that there be no parking for the first 75 feet on each end of Harris Street, and they further request that Harris Street be made a one way street. Councilman LeMay asks if the road can be widened; Town Manager Cox states that the road ends where it is and widening the road would encroach on the adjoining landowners land. Town Manager Cox states that during the Summer the Public Works crew trimmed the overhanging trees back on Harris Street to help with the clearance issue. Town Manager Cox states that she has spoken with the County office and that they do not object with changes being made. Mayor Griffin states that he is not in support of making Harris Street a one way street but is okay with restricting the parking during business hours and making the first 75 feet of the street on both ends of the street no parking; Vice-Mayor Turner and Councilman LeMay agree. Mayor Griffin requests that the current yellow curbing be measured to see what the length of the current no parking area is. This subject was tabled until more members of the Council and possible citizens to comment are present.
- B. Financials-Council reviews the financial statements provided by Town Manager Cox.
- C. Town Hall Improvements-Mayor Griffin states that this subject may need to wait until the entire Council is present. Council discusses the bids presented by Town Manager Cox. Councilman LeMay states that he thinks that the roof on the building needs to be done before improvements to the inside of the building. Town Manager Cox states that both quotes that were received for the replacement of the roof included replacing any rotten boards. Council discusses different options for the proposed restroom, closing in the stairwell, and possibly connecting the Town Hall and the Town Office. This subject was tabled until more members of

the Council are present; Councilman LeMay requests that Town Manager Cox find out what the warranty is on the roof replacement.

TOWN MANAGER'S REPORT

Town Manager Cox asks Council about the idea presented to them by Mike Schumann at the last meeting concerning the vending machine; Vice-Mayor Turner states that he is not in favor of putting in a vending machine because it may open the door for more people requesting vending machines in that area. Councilman LeMay states that he is not in favor of the idea either. Mayor Griffin states that they will table the subject until more members of Council are present.

Town Manager Cox informs Council that she received a bid on the street sweeper but that it was so low that she is going to look into other options for selling it.

OTHER

Councilman LeMay makes a motion, seconded by Vice-Mayor Turner, and unanimously carried, to adjourn to December 17, 2015 at 6:30 pm.
