MEETING CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Griffin called the January 27, 2016 meeting of the Floyd Town Council to order.

ROLL CALL – Vice-Mayor Turner, Councilman LeMay, Mayor Griffin, and Town Manager Cox were present. Councilman Patton arrived late.

PRESENTATION-

The Town Council was invited to attend a presentation from Gary Crouch and Lydeana Martin concerning Conversations on Water in Floyd County. The main focus of the meeting was to share information regarding near term and long term water needs for Floyd. The group also talked about ways to increase known information about water to enable better planning.

Gary Crouch, the Floyd County Public Service Authority’s engineer, will get us started with an overview of water and what we have. We will invite sharing about water use, expected water needs and concerns, and ideas for increasing our knowledge base.

Representatives from the following organizations are being invited: Floyd-Floyd County Public Service Authority, Floyd County Board of Supervisors, Floyd Town Council, Floyd County Economic Development Authority, Floyd County Planning Commission, Floyd County School System, Health Department and representatives of private industry.

Councilman LeMay makes a motion, seconded by Vice-Mayor Turner, and unanimously carried, to adjourn to February 4, 2016 at 6:30 pm.
