MEETING CALL TO ORDER – Vice-Mayor Turner called the July 21, 2016 meeting of the Floyd Town Council to order.

Vice-Mayor Turner asks Patrick Burton from the New River Valley Regional Commission to speak before the public hearing.

Vice-Mayor Turner asks Town Clerk Mandzak if the office has received any written comments concerning the solid waste management plan; Town Clerk Mandzak states that there have been no written comments have been received. Councilman Patton asks if there have been a verbal comments; Town Clerk Mandzak states that there have been no verbal comments.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

- A. Floyd County Solid Waste Management Plan- Councilman Patton asks Mr. Burton how the dates in the chart was determined by the Regional Commission for the Town to replace their trash truck in 2026/2027; Mr. Burton states that the date is just an estimate on when the trash truck may need to be replaced. Vice-Mayor Turner asks if the State requires that this plan be updated at certain times; Mr. Burton states that they do require the plan to be updated at a regular interval but that he can't remember what the exact time line is. Mr. Burton states that once the plan is submitted DEQ has 90 days to report back. Vice-Mayor Turner asks if the majority of the solid waste management plan is concerning the County; Mr. Burton states that is one way to look at it but that the Town definitely has a voice. Councilman Patton states that one way that the Town has made an impact is through the collection of cardboard. Vice-Mayor Turner states that the Council may want to start promoting recycling more.

Councilman Patton makes a motion, seconded by Councilman LeMay, to close the public hearing for the Floyd County Solid Waste Management Plan.
