VRPS Playground Grant



The Town of Floyd received grant funds from Virginia Parks and Recreation Society (VRPS) State-Wide Training and Funding Initiative to create a playground in Warren G. Lineberry Community Park.

The 2,300 square foot playground area includes swings, climbers, and a slide and will be complete Spring of 2019.

VTC Marketing Grant



In August the Town of Floyd was awarded a Marketing Leverage Grant with Virginia Tourism Corporation. These grant funds will be used to create a Town of Floyd artistic point of interest map in both print and digital form.

The map will guide tourist and residents to local points of interest such as, lodging, retail, dining, public parking areas, public restrooms, historic and informational locations, as well as outdoor recreational opportunities. The map will be complete Summer of 2019.

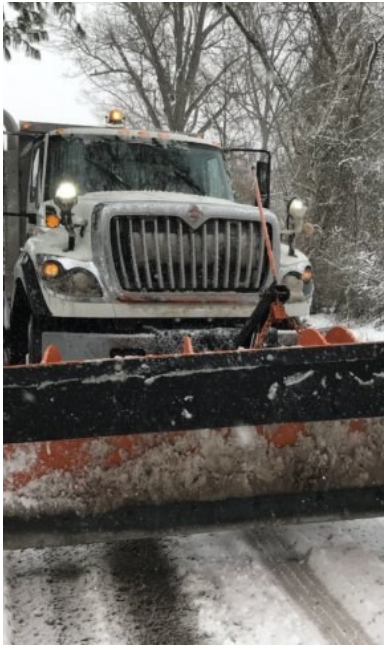

If inclement weather is expected, please avoid parking on the street. Parking on the street prevents snow plows from fully and safely clearing the street and may result in vehicle damage.

The Town will begin clearing sidewalks once the winter weather event ends. Please be respectful and do not pile snow onto sidewalks when clearing your driveway.

Use caution when walking on cleared sidewalks. Even though the sidewalks may appear to be safe, melted snow will refreeze and become slick when the temperature is cool and below freezing.
