

## **Town of Floyd Amnesty Program during the COVID-19 Crisis**

### **Loan Pool Grantees**

The Town Council and town staff are continuously monitoring the current Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. We understand the additional burden this is putting on our small businesses. Therefore, the Town of Floyd would like to offer an amnesty program for our loan pool grantees.

If you have a loan with the Town of Floyd, we will be allowing those monthly payments to be deferred until July 2020 without penalties and interest. For any deferred payment, said payment will be an extension of your loan payoff date. Your balance will be frozen at this moment in time.

We acknowledge we are in a very unpredictable time, so the Town will revisit this program in June to determine if any extensions are necessary.

### **Recycling & Cardboard Services**

At this time, the Town of Floyd will not be collecting business recycling and cardboard or curbside recycling from residents. This will allow the highest protection for our Public Works staff so they will not be handling and sorting recycling materials. We ask that you continue to break down your cardboard and stack as much as you can into another container to help conserve your space. We will continue to collect all garbage on Tuesday and Fridays weekly.
