

Town of Floyd Amnesty Program during the COVID-19 Crisis Meals & Lodging Businesses

The Town Council and town staff are continuously monitoring the current Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. We understand the additional burden this is putting on our small businesses. Therefore, the Town of Floyd would like to offer an amnesty program for our restaurants and lodging facilities.

All penalties and interest on meals and lodging taxes due to the Town of Floyd between March 20 and May 20, 2020 will be waived provided you submit your return by the due date each month. If your return is submitted timely, payment can be delayed without penalties and interest until May 20, 2020 and installments of the balance due may be paid over the next 2 months (June and July) if needed. Timely filing of your returns **MUST** be made in order to defer payments. We hope this measure will support your business with the capital to continue to pay staff and vendors.

We acknowledge we are in a very unpredictable time, so the Town will revisit this program in May to determine if any extensions are necessary.

Recycling & Cardboard Services

At this time, the Town of Floyd will not be collecting business recycling and cardboard or curbside recycling from residents. This will allow the highest protection for our Public Works staff so they will not be handling and sorting recycling materials. We ask that you continue to break down your cardboard and stack as much as you can into another container to help conserve your space. We will continue to collect all garbage on Tuesday and Fridays weekly.
